

ACME 2019 Transportation Guidance

From the Seattle Tacoma Airport (SEA), it is convenient to take the airporter bus to Bellingham four points hotel. It is important to book a ticket a few days before your travel from this website (<http://www.airporter.com>). The cost is around 40 dollars one way to Bellingham.

From the Bellingham Airport (BLI), you may take a taxi or Uber to any Bellingham hotel.

From the Vancouver Airport (VYR), you may take the quick shuttle to the Bellingham airport. It is also a good idea to book a ticket a few days before travel (<https://www.ridebooker.com/transfers/yvr/bli/quick-shuttle>). The cost is around 40 Canadian dollars one way to Bellingham. Note: If you are not a US or Canadian citizen, you might need an electronic travel authorization (eTA website: <https://www.canada.ca/en/immigration-refugees-citizenship/services/visit-canada/eta.html>) or Canadian visa to land in YVR airport, then travel to US.
